1120 MANAGEMENT TEAM

Proper administration of the school is most vital to a successful education program. The general purpose of the district's administration shall be to coordinate and supervise, under the policies of the Board, the creation and operation of an environment in which students learn most effectively. Administrative duties and functions should be appraised in terms of the contribution made to improving instruction and learning. The Board shall rely on its chief executive officer, the district Superintendent, to provide the professional administrative leadership demanded by such a far-reaching goal.

The district's administrative organization shall be designed so that the Board policies are implemented through the district Superintendent. The mere execution of the directives cannot, by itself, be construed as good administration. Vision, initiative, resourcefulness and wise leadership - as well as consideration and concern for staff members, students, parents, and others - are essential for effective administration.

The district Superintendent and other administrators shall have the authority and responsibility necessary for his or her specific administrative assignment. Each shall likewise be accountable for the effectiveness with which the administrative assignment is carried out.
